Background

MUN Students' Union (MUNSU) represents over 13,000 undergraduate students studying through Memorial University of Newfoundland's St. John's campus. MUNSU is a not-for-profit organization that advocates for students through campaigns and lobbying while also providing cost-saving services and student life programming for its members.

Salary: \$14.05 per hour – biweekly pay; 40 or 80 total hours over the semester (position can be filled by two students for 40 hours each, or one student for 80 hours)

Duration: Hours must be completed during the Spring 2019 semester (which includes Intersession/Summer semesters)

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a MUNSU member, registered in at least one undergraduate course during the Spring (/Intersession/Summer) semester
- Must not be on a work term
- Must meet university MUCEP academic requirements

Job Description & Qualifications

Working directly with the Executive Director of Campaigns, this role will provide assistance with planning and promoting Campus Pride events. This position is an opportunity to shape and contribute to year-round pride on campus, to influence a positive culture and community at Memorial, and to create an impactful event.

Due to the level of responsibility associated with this position, strong leadership skills will be required. The selected candidate(s) will have demonstrated accountability and previous involvement with the local Pride community in some way. They should have an interest in making Campus Pride a successful event and be excited to not only come up with creative ideas but to put in the work to make sure they come to life.

Here's what we're looking for in an ideal candidate:

- Strong leadership, communication, creative, and strategic skills
- Ability to stay organized, manage time, and oversee volunteers

- Previous involvement with MUNSU, the Memorial community, and/or local pride groups
