Background

MUN Students' Union (MUNSU) represents over 13,000 undergraduate students studying through Memorial University of Newfoundland's St. John's campus. MUNSU is a not-for-profit organization that advocates for students through campaigns and lobbying while also providing cost-saving services and student life programming for its members.

Salary: \$14.05 per hour (biweekly pay); 40 total hours over the semester

Duration: Hours must be completed during the Fall 2019 semester

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a MUNSU member registered full-time during the semester (minimum three courses)
- Must not be on a work term
- Must meet university MUCEP academic requirements

Job Description & Qualifications

Working directly with the Executive Director of External Affairs, Communications, and Research, this role will assist with researching, planning, and revising MUNSU's internal policies. Student needs are continually changing, and MUNSU's policies need to be continually updated to reflect that, as well as to correct and improve inefficiencies.

The selected candidate for this position will need an understanding of both policy and of the current issues affecting MUNSU's diverse membership of over 13,000 undergraduate students; it would be helpful to have a working familiarity with the students' union and its policies.

- Familiarity with MUN Students' Union and its structure, programs, services, and policies
- Interest in public policy, post-secondary education, and/or the student movement
