Background

MUN Students' Union (MUNSU) represents over 13,000 undergraduate students studying through Memorial University of Newfoundland's St. John's campus. MUNSU is a not-for-profit organization that advocates for students through campaigns and lobbying while also providing cost-saving services and student life programming for its members.

Salary: \$14.05 per hour – biweekly pay; 40 or 80 total hours over the semester (position can be filled by two students for 40 hours each, or one student for 80 hours)

Duration: Hours must be completed during the Fall 2019 semester

Eligibility Requirements

- Must be a MUNSU member registered full-time during the semester (minimum three courses)
- Must not be on a work term
- Must meet university MUCEP academic requirements

Job Description & Qualifications

Working directly with the Executive Director of Student Life, this role will provide assistance with planning and promoting MUNSU's events and student activities. This position is an opportunity to shape and contribute to student life, to influence a positive culture and community on campus, and to create memorable, engaging experiences for MUN students.

Due to the self-directed nature of this position, strong leadership skills will be required. The selected candidate will have a demonstrated ability to work independently. They should be excited to come up with creative ideas for fun events, but also committed to following through with the required planning to make their ideas come to life.

- Strong leadership, communication, creative, and strategic skills
- Ability to stay organized, manage time, and oversee volunteers
- Previous involvement with MUNSU, the Memorial community, and/or event planning
- Interest in and knowledge of student life at MUN; 'in touch' with MUN students
